Competence targets

The aim of the teaching:

1. The student has basic knowledge of professional English used in gardening, agriculture, landscaping or animal care.
2. The student can speak in English with other students about a professional topic in gardening, agriculture, landscaping or animal care.
3. The student can receive vocational and educational training in English in gardening, agriculture, landscaping or animal care.
4. The student will gain knowledge about Scandinavian culture.
5. The student will gain international competences.

Roskilde Cathedral

Roskilde Cathedral has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1995. With its many unique royal chapels the Cathedral reflects the changing European architectural history across 800 years and is an early Scandinavian Gothic cathedral built in bricks. A World Heritage site is a monument or place that has important significance in the history of mankind. Today more than 1000 sites are inscribed on the World Heritage List by UNESCO, including the Pyramids, the Great Wall of China and Grand Canyon. Tivoli

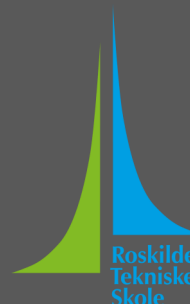
